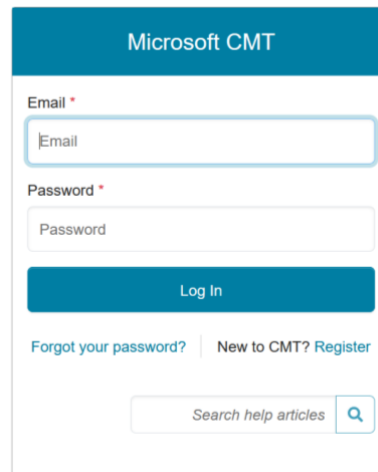
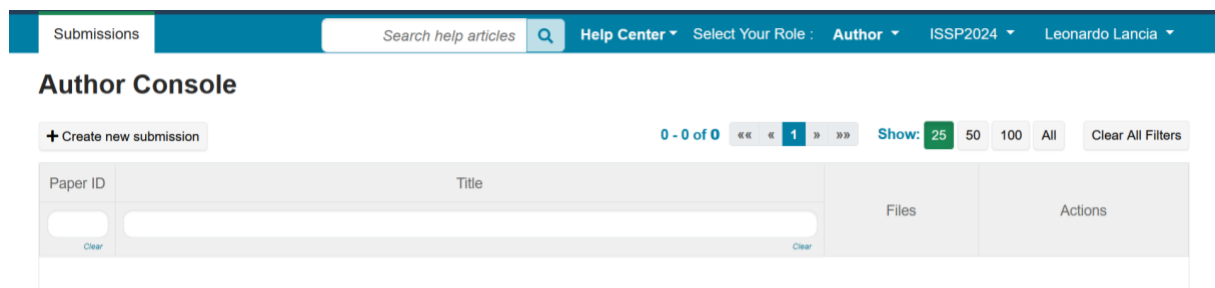


If you have a Microsoft CMT account you should log in with the e-mail linked to the account and with your password. If you do not have an account, you should create one by clicking on the link Register (additional info on the registration process is available here <https://cmt3.research.microsoft.com/docs/help/general/account-creation.html>).

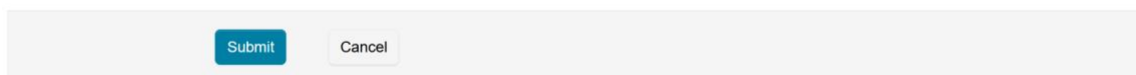
